

## HEDIS Provider Guide: Prenatal Immunization Status (PRS-E)

Measure Description
<p>The percentage of deliveries in the measurement period in which members received influenza and tetanus, diphtheria toxoids, and acellular pertussis (Tdap) vaccinations</p> <p><b>Immunization Status</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Influenza:</b> Deliveries where members received an adult influenza vaccine on or between July 1st of the year prior to the measurement period and the delivery date</li> <li><b>Tdap:</b> Deliveries where members received at least one Tdap during the pregnancy (including on delivery date)</li> </ul> <p><b>Documentation Tips</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If a patient has more than one delivery in a 180-day period, include only the first eligible delivery.</li> <li>The denominator for this measure is based on deliveries, not on members; therefore, it is possible for the denominator to include multiple deliveries for the same person.</li> <li>Vaccines given before pregnancy or after delivery do not count.</li> <li>The pregnancy start date is calculated by subtracting the gestational age (weeks) at delivery from the delivery date, using the most recent gestational age assessment or diagnosis within one (1) day of delivery.</li> </ul> <p><b>Exclusions</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Members in hospice</li> <li>Deliveries that occurred at less than 37 weeks gestation</li> </ul>

### How to Improve HEDIS® Scores

- Use the California State Immunization Registry (CAIR) to record immunizations: <https://cair.cdph.ca.gov>.
- Some vaccines may have been given before the patients were Blue Shield Promise members. Transcribe those vaccinations into CAIR even if your practice did not provide the vaccine.
- Educate patients on the importance of vaccinations during pregnancy in order to help protect their baby.
- Make every office visit count. Take advantage of every visit to catch up on needed vaccines.
- Set flags in your electronic health record to indicate members needing vaccinations.
- Address misconceptions, anxiety, and fear regarding vaccinations during pregnancy.

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
